We voted YES for safe staffing

We need an economic package that will fill our thousands of vacancies across the system. That's why we all came together to vote **YES** on our elected bargaining team's values and priorities.

Our values

- We value each other and the work we all do to ensure patients get the care they need in every corner of the system.
- We value Racial Justice to ensure Providence Swedish is a place where we all belong.

Our Priorities

- To ensure patients receive quality care in every part of the system, we will bargain a full economic package that recruits and retains qualified staff from around the area.
- Achieve equitable wages and benefits through data and marketdriven research that makes us the leader again in healthcare and allows us to live in the communities in which we work.
- Work toward racial justice, equity, and respect for all in both patient care delivery and our workplace.



"I am proud of the work we all do at Swedish because Swedish has always had prestige in our community. But when I go into work, I feel worried that we won't have everything that we need to do our best job and I see how difficult it is for my other coworkers too. Our solutions to recruit and retain

Our problems with hiring and keeping staff are compounding our unsafe staffing conditions and leading to more turnover. Short staffing in all our units means many of us are taking more call and overtime to keep patients safe, and has led to record high burnout rates.

Our elected bargaining team is using these values and priorities to gather data and create marketdriven proposals that will recruit and retain:



- Wages and market adjustments
- Credit for experience for current and new **Service and Tech employees**
- Addressing ghost steps
- Premiums and differentials, including Stand By, Shift, Weekend, Charge/Lead, Preceptor, etc.
- ★ Incentive shifts (Stand By and Scheduled)
- Retention bonuses
- * Retirement
- Break relief
- Retaining experienced senior employees
- Addressing call and standby issues

"Our power is in our numbers, and the more we come together—like we did in the proposal vote—the more we are able to show Providence that we're unhappy with how they have handled the staffing crisis. We have an opportunity with this economic reopener to know how serious they are about addressing recruitment and retention—how ready they are to work

with us to fix things. We don't know what to

expect but we'll have a better picture after we meet with them in August. What we do know is that we need to stand together to be strong and not let them divide us along our differences.
